You will use your learning and be able to see through different instructional lenses and to embrace your creativity.

Scene 1

Create at least two predictions based on Banquo's character from Act 1 to now on what might happen to him in future scenes.

Based on Lady Macbeth and Macbeth's interactions, has their relationship changed at any point? If so or not so, explain at least three reasons why using and analysing specific quotes in the scene.

Choose three quotes spoken by Macbeth that reflect your initial text conversation on Macbeth's conversation with the murderers. Analyse each quote based on imagery and diction used to explain how the quote relates to your text conversation.

You have just attended Macbeth's party during this scene. Describe your impressions of Macbeth's party by writing a letter using ReadWriteTalk (website link in the MCCO) to a friend who has not gone to the party.
